



Apply for funding

The JOBA Employment Fund will accept applications during the 3rd and 4th quarter of 2016. Specific deadlines will be announced during the launch of the Employment Fund in August 2016.

There will be a maximum of 12 grants.

The implementation period for each grant will normally be 3 years, to be completed by March 2020.

Your institution's eligibility for funding will be considered in accordance with the following:

Eligibility


- Training programmes provided;
- Target sectors;
- Geographic spread of implementation;
- Organizational Management & ownership;
- Quality and access to training materials, tools, equipment and facilities;
- Career Counselling Life Skills, etc;
- Technology & innovation;
- Network & partnerships;
- Target women, girls & other disadvantaged groups;
- The proposed budget;
- Tailor made curriculum in accordance with labour market needs;
- Provision of adequate support to learners ensuring employment;
- Project sustainability;
- Experience in TVET training;
- Entrepreneurship skills training;
- Qualified & experienced trainers;
- Training methodology (i.e. competency based training);
- Co-funding ;
 - 50% / 50% for commercial entities
 - 20% / 80% for NGO's

EOI (Request for Expression of Interest)

The first step in submitting a funding request is to use our online inquiry system. You will fill out a brief form summarizing your project with add annexes if necessary. We will send you an acknowledgment that your message was received. We will direct it to our appropriate programme staff members for review.
 - 02**
Appraisal of EOI

JOBA will evaluate the Expressions of Interest using the set evaluation criteria to pre-select the applicants.
 - 03**
Selection process

Selection process by JOBA for progression to full Application
Pre-selected applicants will receive an invitation to submit a full proposal.
 - 04**
Development of full Proposal

If JOBA has selected the applicant to prepare a full proposal, we will contact you via email with a link to the proposal form.
 - 05**
Proposal Submission

During this process, all applicants will receive technical support through a Facilitator, after estimating the type and amount of facilitator support they need from JOBA in developing the full proposal.
 - 06**
Evaluation

You will be required to submit a proposal with a technical and financial section. Submission of the proposal is to be done in accordance with the Application Toolkit Guidelines and Budget Guidelines.
 - 07**
Contract Process

The proposals will be evaluated against a set of selection criteria, as part of a competitive process. JOBA may suggest various forms of partnerships for applicants, including contracts, grants, loans, programme-related investments, or other kinds of investments and partnerships.
- Time frame** The timeframe of the evaluation of proposals depends on the amount and complexity of proposals submitted. You will be notified of the outcome of the evaluation once the competition of proposals has determined which proposals will attract a grant. Materials submitted in the proposal process become the property of JOBA and won't be returned. They'll be used as JOBA deems appropriate. We may show them to others at our discretion.
- Note** JOBA is under no obligation to fund a proposal. Those applicants whose proposals were selected and who will be eligible for the grant, will be submitted to a due diligence process. If the due diligence process is successfully completed a grant contract will be prepared, negotiated and signed.

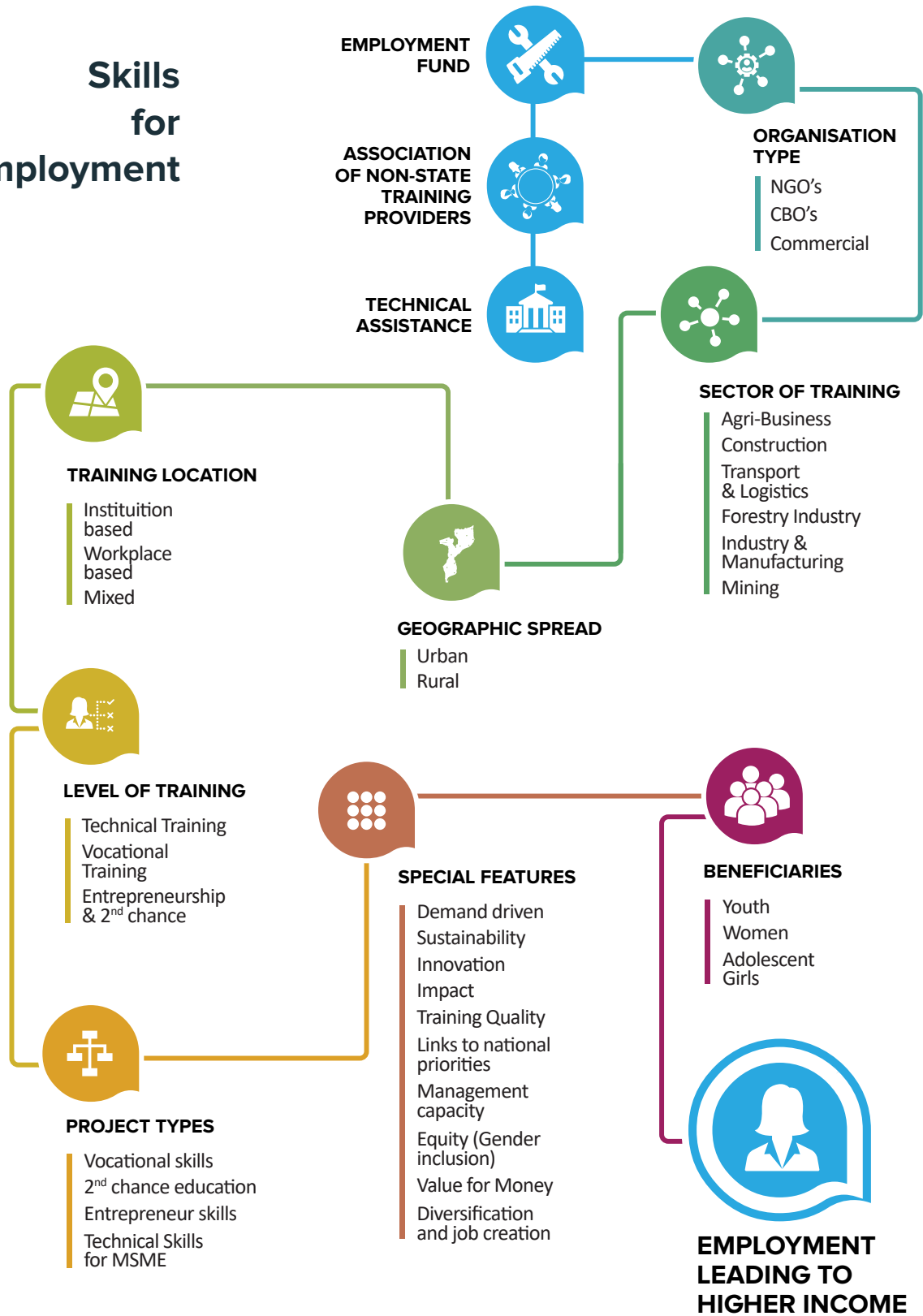
